

INFLUENZA VACCINATION INFORMATION

Influenza immunizations are required for all volunteers during flu season – October 1st through March 31st each year.

Employee Health Services provides flu shots at no charge to volunteers, however you are welcome to receive your immunization elsewhere if you choose. Please retain any documentation provided to you when you receive your flu shot. We will ask you to show this documentation to us to satisfy this requirement.

Information on when and where LLUMC - Murrieta will offer influenza immunizations will be sent via email as soon as it becomes available.

If you are under 18 years of age, you will not be able to volunteer during flu season. If you turn 18 before April 1st, please contact us so we can change your status and process you as an adult volunteer.

IMPORTANT: You are not permitted to volunteer if you do not receive an influenza immunization. If you make the personal choice not to receive the immunization, your status will be changed to "In-Active". At this point, you cannot volunteer or record hours. If you would like to continue volunteering once Flu Season is over, we would love to have you back! Please contact us on, or after April 1st. At that time we will verify that all compliance items are met and reactivate your status.

Please know that we value your service. You are asked to receive an influenza immunization for the safety of our patients. If your choice is not to receive the immunization, we hope to see you again in the spring!
